- to prevent the decline of children's play.

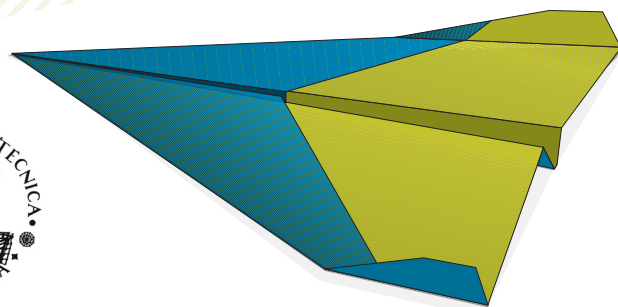
